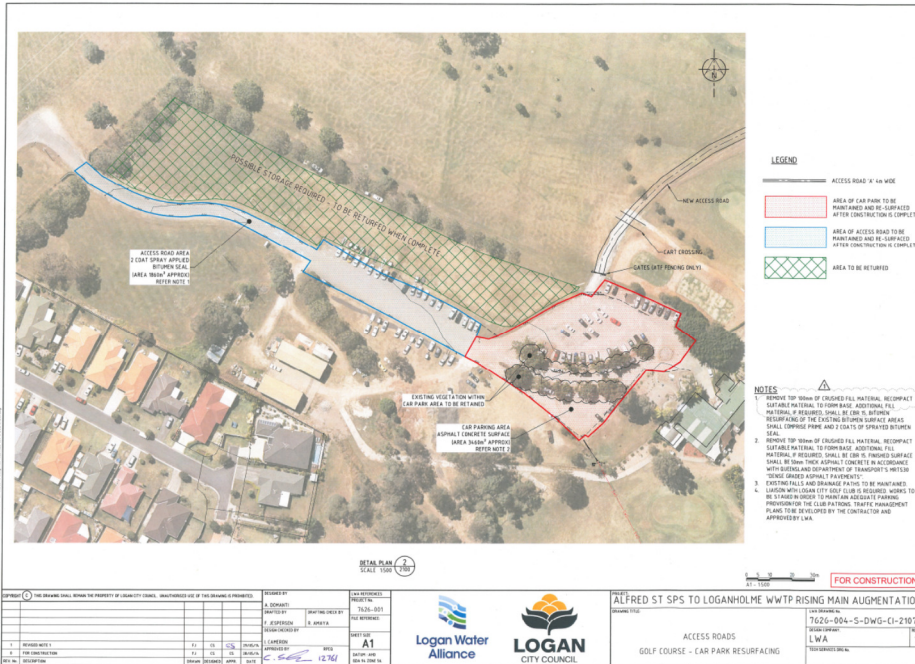

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One of Brisbane's most affordable golf courses, the Logan City Golf Club attracts a high number of week day and weekend patrons across its 27 holes.

This project involved the removal and upgrading of the course's car park and access road including the installation of new kerb and lighting.

The car park was upgraded from a severely deteriorated bitumen surface to a new asphaltic pavement featuring new kerb, garden beds and lighting.

The access road was widened to include additional parking bays for light vehicles with trailers and was given a new pavement surfaced with a bituminous seal.

One of the complexities of this project was that it needed to be constructed under traffic whilst the course remained open and fully operational.

Civcorp met this challenge and kept the course and parking areas open during the construction phase.

The works were finished 1 week ahead of programme and opened in time for the course's reopening of 9 flood damaged holes.

This project was one of a series of projects awarded to Civcorp by the Logan Water Alliance following a successful working relationship and happy client.
