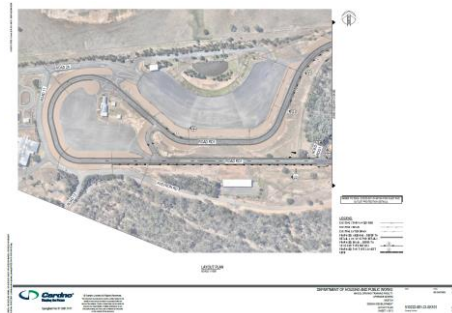

The Department of Housing and Public Works engaged Civcorp to undertake an upgrade to the Queensland Police's Driver Training Facility at Wacol.

The initial project scope was to repair erosion damage, however once Civcorp commenced the works the scope was vastly extended to undertake track improvements, shoulder widening, embankment, guardrail and kerbing works along with improved drainage and bitumen reseals.
