Long Pocket, Indooroopilly



Continuing on our long term relationship with key client, Paynter Dixon, Civcorp constructed the civil component of an upgrade to the University of Queensland's Long Pocket Campus located at Indooroopilly.

The works were focused primarily around Blocks C and D which were being upgraded both internally and externally.

As part of this Civcorp provided all of the earthworks for various trades including footpath preparation, bulk excavation, cut to fill, precast drainage installation, ACCO drain installation with heel proof grates and fittings, the construction of two new asphalt car parking areas along with the rehabilitation of service crossing, road repairs and areas damaged by other trades during the construction works.



Due to the limited amount of room available on site the work areas provided to Civcorp were often small and frequently changing around other trades. Civcorp worked closely with not only Paynter Dixon, but also the other trades onsite, to manage our work areas and priorities so as not to disrupt or impede the works of others.

Overall Civcorp is on track to complete all of our assigned works.
