



Christensen Road South i3 Consulting



Civcorp was contracted to construct a new section of road to extend the Christensen Road South industrial subdivision. Civcorp's experience in bulk earthworks and management of unsuitable materials was key in ensuring the project remained on schedule and materials were used efficiently. The construction of large rock retaining walls was completed by a subcontractor while supervised by Civcorp.

Stormwater, sewer, water and electrical services were installed in the road reserve. Connections into existing stormwater, sewer and water infrastructure were managed and completed per GCCC specifications. Construction of the 3800m² road included subgrade preparation, base installation, and the laying of over 450 tonnes of Council C320 Asphalt.

A bioretention basin and artificial wetland was also constructed as part of the project, Civcorp ensured adherence to environmental management systems while developing this sensitive area.
